We were also invited along to the Active Essex sports awards as nominees for community club of the year, Kangei came away as the winners which is well deserved as everybody here puts a huge amount of time and effort into making our club the best it can be, we are all immensely grateful for the recognition.

Everyone here is truly humbled at the dedication our members show by travelling the length and breadth of the country. Without this we wouldn't have been able to achieve the huge medal haul that we did last year. Some of our juniors travelled to Scotland where we left with 5 medals, taking 2nd on the minor's medal chart at Britain's premier international judo competition. Sheffield was the venue for some of our higher-level competitions. Victors were made, boys British schools champion, two English minors champions and a bronze pre-cadet medal was awarded. Venturing to wales where sensei Steve returned from competition retirement to become British masters champion 73kg M2 category. £10 per person or £15 per couple.






