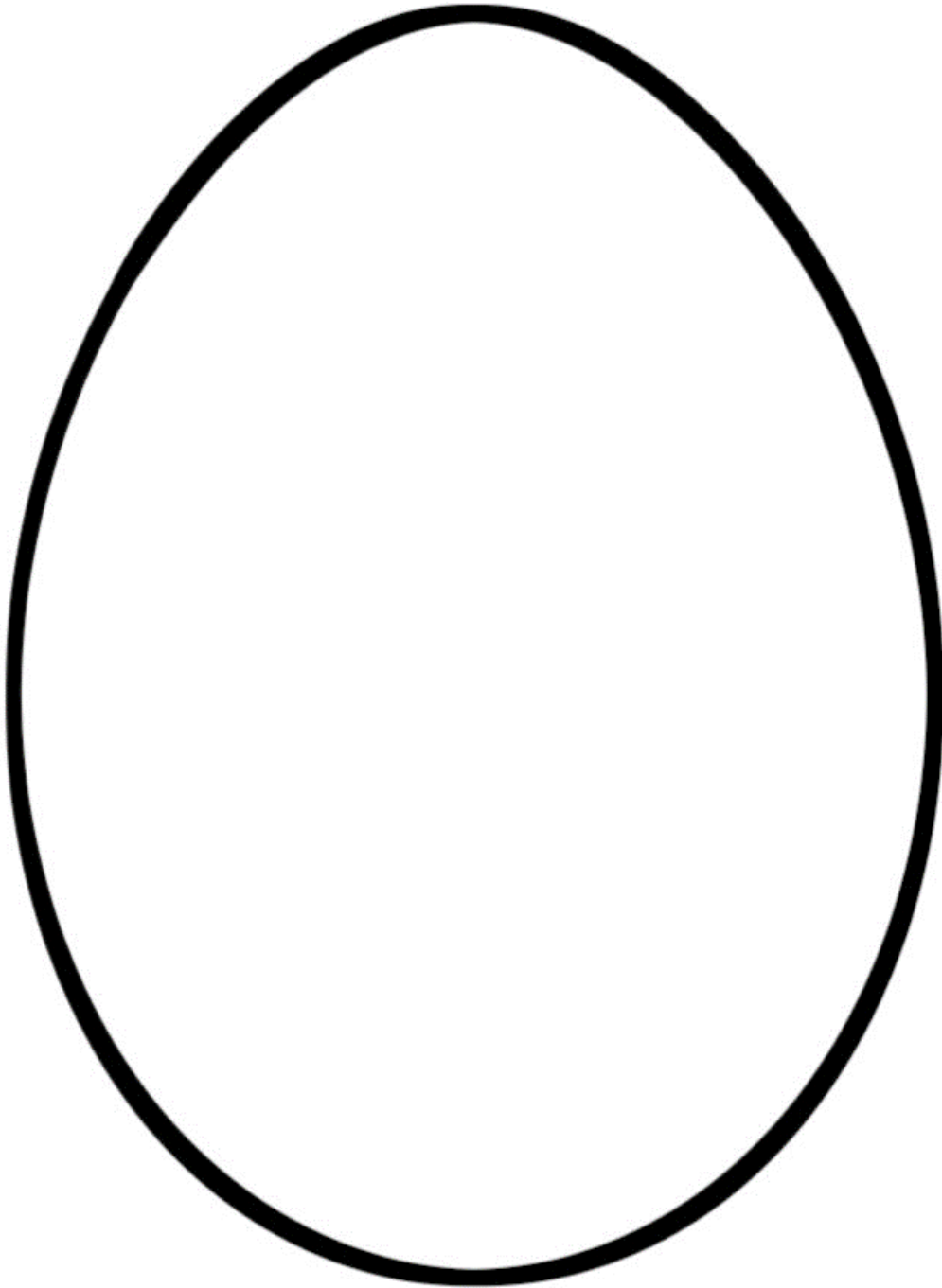
Our 1st under 8’s festival
